Transformation Station Volunteer Guidelines

Effective January 1, 2012

In order to participate in this program, you must agree to the following:

1. You will be contacted to begin volunteering when your name gets to the top of the list for the item you have signed up for. If we do not reach you, you will have six months to contact us. Once we hear from you, you will be able to start volunteering once we have an opening.
2. This is a volunteer program. You are offering your time to Good Works to help us address needs in the community. You will be working alongside staff, volunteers and groups. Volunteers are an essential part of what we do and what gets accomplished.
3. If you will be late or not able to come, we expect that you will call (594-3336) to let us know. If you do not call to let us know you will be late, you will not be allowed to volunteer that day. If you do not call to tell us that you are not able to come in, you will be removed from the current volunteer list. When you do call us, you can start volunteering again once we have an opening.
4. The start time for Transformation Station volunteers is 8:45. If you arrive after 9am you will not be allowed to volunteer that day unless you have called to tell us you will be late.
5. We offer gifts to volunteers who participate in the Transformation Station from items that have been donated to Good Works. We do not guarantee the condition of these items nor do we guarantee that they will work for any particular length of time. You will be responsible for purchasing any parts that are needed for maintenance on the item. You cannot return an item that stops working to exchange it for another.
6. You cannot reserve an item for yourself. You can only select and receive your particular item when you have all the points you need for that item.
7. We do not provide delivery or installation of the item you have selected. You will have to make arrangements for this. Your gift (vehicles, appliances, furniture, food) must be picked up within 30 days from the last day you volunteered. After 30 days, any items not removed from Good Works become the property of Good Works.
8. You are only eligible to receive one gift per period of volunteer service. You cannot add items during a current volunteer time. After you have finished you may sign up to receive

another item. It may be necessary for you to wait until others have completed their volunteer hours before you can begin to volunteer again.

9. Children under the age of 16 are not permitted here during your times of service.
10. Friends or family members 16 and older can help you get the item you are seeking. They will need to call to complete a telephone interview and set up a time to come for a volunteer tour and complete a written application before the day they volunteer. They must come on the days that you volunteer and their volunteer times will go to your credit. After completing the application, they will be eligible to sign up for the Transformation Station themselves. You can have up to three people sign up to help you, however, only one person at a time can volunteer with you at a time. Your helper cannot volunteer with you unless you also are present volunteering.
11. We do not allow substitutions in this program. You cannot send someone to volunteer in your place. You must be present for any points you earn.
12. You will have 30 days from the time you finish volunteering to pick up your item.
13. If you do not finish your volunteer service we will send a letter to the address you indicated on this application. You will have six months from the last day you volunteered to complete your points or select another item. After that time, all points are forfeited and you are not eligible to receive a gift. You may sign up to volunteer at a later time.
14. If you do not take an item with the points you have received, we will send a letter to the address you indicated on this application. You will have six months from the last day you volunteered to complete your points or select another item. After that time, all points are forfeited and you are not eligible to receive a gift. You may sign up to volunteer at a later time.
15. You cannot use volunteer hours from this program for hours required by another agency (such as court referred community service or Department of Job and Family Services).

Additional guidelines for those volunteering for vehicles:

1. Cars that have been donated to us have high mileage and are transferred to you in AS-IS condition. They are not recommended for long trips outside the area. Before accepting a vehicle, you may have a friend or mechanic check out its condition. While we are careful to accept only vehicles that are running and appear to be in good condition, we cannot guarantee that they will last any particular amount of time.
2. Volunteers can only receive one vehicle. Members of the same household cannot volunteer for additional vehicles.
3. You cannot volunteer for other items while you are also volunteering for a vehicle. You may however sign up while you are volunteering to receive other items after you have finished volunteering for a vehicle. The exception to this is food. If you need a crate of food and would like to use a point for this, you may do so, but you must call us before you come in to volunteer. You cannot show up and decide that you want a crate of food that day.
4. Before you begin to volunteer, you must have a current, valid Driver's License that is not under suspension and with no fines due.
5. You must pay for title and registration fees, which usually amount to around \$75.
6. You must be able to insure the vehicle and present proof of insurance before the vehicle will be transferred to you. This must be done prior to the day you come to volunteer and receive your vehicle.
7. The title of the vehicle will be transferred into your name only. We will not transfer a vehicle to anyone else.
8. If it is determined that you are not eligible to register a vehicle due to problems connected with your Driver's License, you will have six months to correct the problem and may select a vehicle that is available at that time. The current vehicle you have selected will be titled back to Good Works at your expense. After six months, you will forfeit the points you have received and will not be eligible to receive another item. You may sign up to receive another vehicle, but you will be placed at the bottom of the list and can begin volunteering when your name comes up.
