The Community of Good Works, located in Athens, Ohio (host city to Ohio University) is praying for the LORD to send laborers to serve along-side us in our ministry with people in poverty. We have been providing care and community to adults and children who struggle with poverty, homelessness, and vulnerability (addiction, mental distress) since 1981.

We are looking for a mission-minded person to join our community and work with us as we share our lives and faith while we care for adults and children who experience poverty and homelessness. We are especially focused on caring for the stranger (adults and children who experience homelessness in rural SE Ohio), widows (mostly older adults), and children who struggle with poverty.

House Supervisors oversee the operations of the Good Works Timothy House, our shelter for people without homes in eight southeastern Ohio counties. Duties include maintaining a safe, clean, and stable place for people to live temporarily, communicating effectively with residents, as well as community members through the phone or at the door, and performing various intake procedures.

As staff grow in the gifts God has entrusted to them, they may become involved in Caregiving—working individually with a small number of residents to provide care, accountability, and resources to help them recover from their situation of homelessness.

We are praying that the LORD will send Jesus followers, laborers who love the LORD and have a heart to grow in discipleship and mission alongside other believers in the body of Christ, using the gifts God has entrusted to them to love and serve the poor. Good Works, a community of HOPE located in southeast Ohio has been engaged in mission and relationships with people who struggle with poverty in rural Ohio for 42 years. Our primary focus has been to care for widows, children from unstable situations, and strangers. Our community is praying that the LORD would send us a missional-minded family (including children)) to serve alongside us as we open a new initiative in the summer of 2023 to expand our ministry to people in poverty who struggle with a disability and homelessness. Our new initiative, Sign of HOPE, will serve adults and children that our current shelter (The Timothy House) is unable to serve. We are seeking a mission minded family to live in our newly constructed two-bedroom apartment in our neighborhood, and oversee the care and community of those who stay there and those who visit there. Good Works has 3 locations. Our new facility is in the city of Athens (Ohio) across the street from our shelter, The Timothy House. The new house has a front room to provide hospitality for our neighbors and others; and 4 washers/dryers in the basement to serve a broader community of people at the point of their need to do laundry. Those who serve with us serve alongside a larger staff team, and will live in a newly constructed apartment.
